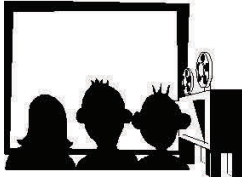


Welcome to Campden Baptist Church, in the heart of the lovely Cotswold Hills!

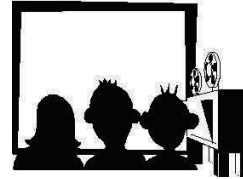
